One Minutes (15 per side)

H.Con.Res. 312 - The Concurrent Resolution on the Budget for FY 2009 (Structured Rule)
(Sponsored by Rep. Spratt / Budget Committee)

The rule provides for four hours of general debate and makes in order the following amendments:

- Kilpatrick / Scott (VA) Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute** (60 minutes)
- Lee Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute** (60 minutes)
- Ryan (WI) Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute** (60 minutes)

Suspensions (4 Bills):

- 1) **H.R. 5578** - Short-term Farm Bill Extension (Sponsored by Rep. Peterson / Agriculture Committee)
- 2) **H.R. 3361** - To make technical corrections related to the Pension Protection Act of 2006
(Sponsored by Rep. Rangel / Ways and Means Committee)
- 3) **H.Res. 991** - Recognizing the exceptional sacrifice of the 69th Infantry Regiment, known as the Fighting 69th, in support of the Global War on Terror (Sponsored by Rep. Israel / Armed Services Committee)
- 4) **H.Res. 953** - Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that all Americans should participate in a moment of silence to reflect upon the service and sacrifice of members of the United States Armed Forces both at home and abroad, and their families (Sponsored by Rep. Knollenberg / Armed Services Committee)

- 3) **S. 2733** - To temporarily extend the programs under the Higher Education Act of 1965
(Sponsored by Sen. Kennedy / Education and Labor Committee)
