H.R. 3962 - Speaker Pelosi's Government Takeover of Health Care (Structured Rule)
(Sponsored by Rep. Dingell / Energy and Commerce Committee)

The rule provides for four hours of general debate and makes in order the following amendments:

Boehner Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute (60 minutes)

- 7) **H.Res. 833** - Honoring the 60th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between the United States and the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, the 10th anniversary of the accession to the throne of His Majesty King Abdullah II Ibn Al Hussein (Sponsored by Rep. Schiff / Foreign Affairs Committee)
- 8) **H.Res. 209** - Commemorating the 30th anniversary of the seizure of the U.S. hostages in Iran (Sponsored by Rep. Fortenberry / Foreign Affairs Committee)
- 9) **H.Res. 895** - Honoring the lives of the brave soldiers of the United States Army who lost their lives in the tragic attack of November 5, 2009, at Fort Hood, Texas (Sponsored by Rep. Carter / Armed Services Committee)
